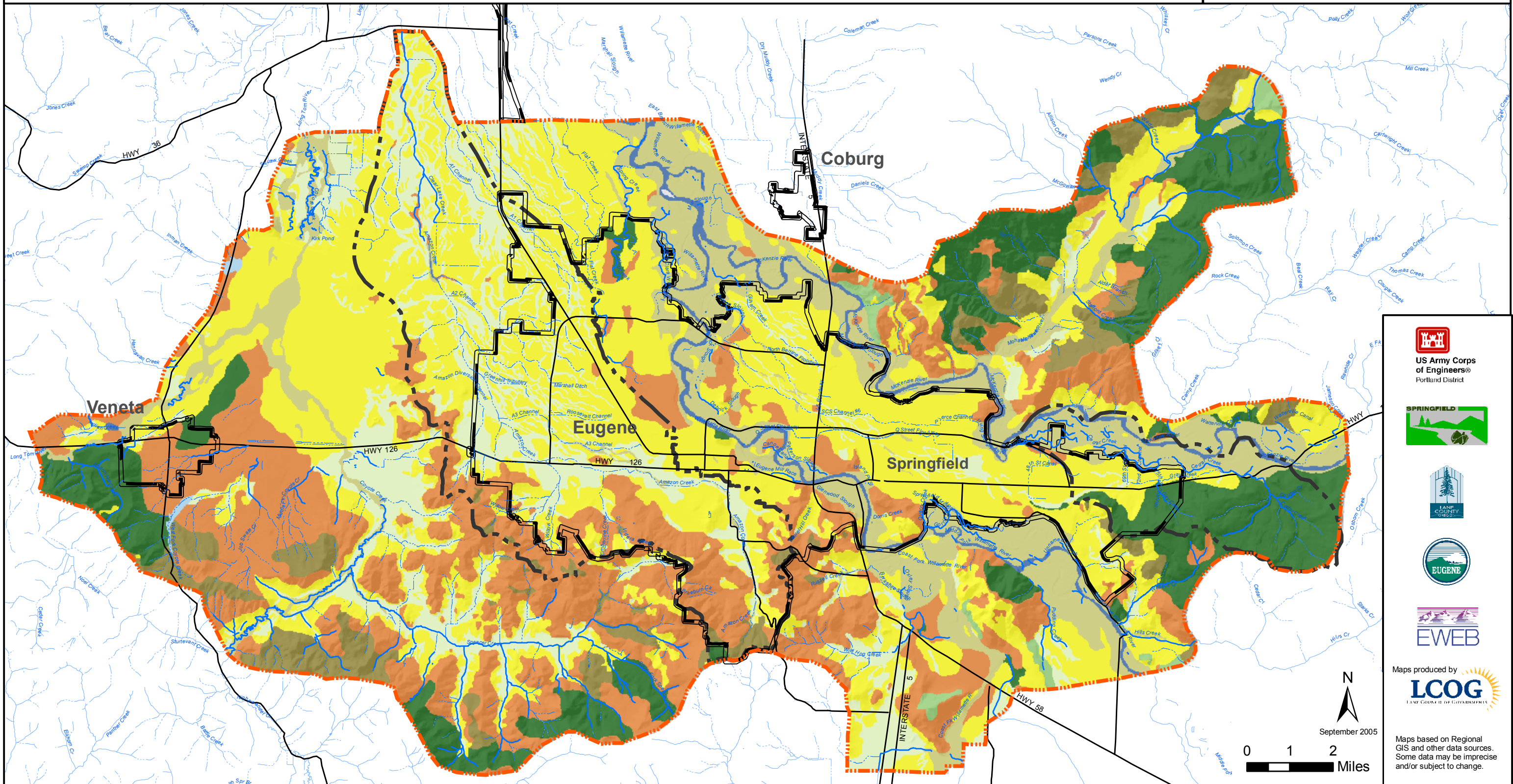
HISTORIC HABITAT TYPES (Ca. 1851)
